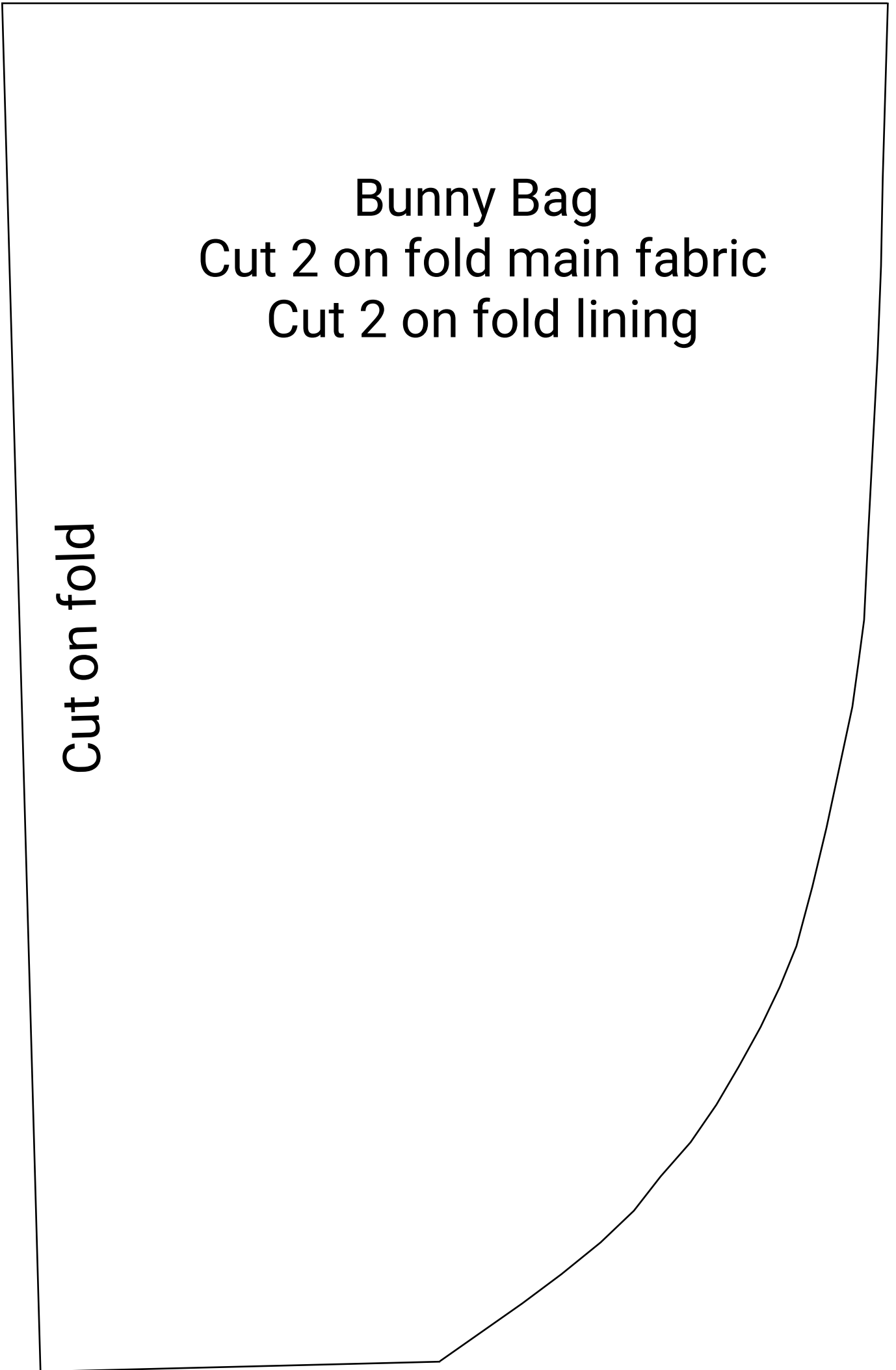


Bunny Bag Ear
Cut 2 main fabric
Cut 2 lining fabric

Bunny Bag
Cut 2 on fold main fabric
Cut 2 on fold lining

Cut on fold



Bunny Bag Instructions

- Trace out your pattern, cut 2 on fold in main fabric and lining, plus one bag piece on fold in interfacing cut 2 ears in main fabric and 2 ears in lining
 - Iron interfacing to back of one main fabric
- Draw your bunny's face on with a water soluble marker or chalk
- Hand embroider your bunny's face, I use a simple back stitch, there are lots of youtube tutorials for embroidery if you need some help with this step
 - With right sides together sew your bag around the curved seam leaving the top open.
- Repeat for the lining, leaving a 5cm space open at the base to turn your bag through
- Sew your ears, with right sides together, with one main piece and one lining piece for each ear
 - Trim the bulk away

- Turn your ears right side out
- Stitch a button hole on either side of the main bag, 2cm down from the top, this is to thread your ribbon through
- Place the bag lining inside the bag outer with right sides together
- Place the ears inside the bag on the backside (not the side where you have embroidered your face) with the lining facing down
- Stotch around the top of the bag, catching the ears in place
 - Turn right side out through the hole you left in the bottom of the lining
 - Press (Iron)
- Top stitch the top of the bag to create the channel for your ribbon. One row 1cm from the top and another 3cm down, ensure your button hole lands within this channel
- Use a safety pin to thread a piece of ribbon through from each side, creating adraw string
 - Your bunny bag is done.
